Business GROW-HOW

DEADLOCK

My printing company has two shareholders/directors, each holding 50% of the issued shares. Our relationship has become fraught recently as we fundamentally disagree on future strategy. My colleague is now refusing to attend board and shareholder meetings, so no decisions can be taken. Is there anything I can do?

It is important to state first of all that I am assuming that the quorum for both board meetings and shareholder meetings is two.

This being the case and subject to any special provisions in the company's Articles of Association, there may be no way forward if your colleague refuses to attend convened meetings.

Even if he were to attend but you failed to agree on certain issues, then any voting could be 'deadlocked'.

The company's Articles may provide for a casting vote, typically by the chairman of the board. Clearly this will only be beneficial to you if a chairman has been duly appointed and that chairman is you!

The courts are generally reluctant to interfere in situations such as yours. You may be forced to consider the somewhat drastic solution of winding up the company either by agreement or by a petition to the court.

My advice is to do this only as a last resort. Other possible solutions are:-

- Negotiate and try to resolve your differences through an intermediary.
- Agree an alternative method of resolving deadlock situations.
- Consider ways of splitting the business between you.
- One buys the other out.
- The business is sold.
- Appoint an arbitrator or a neutral individual with a casting vote.

This is a sad case and both of you need to recognise that the current situation will undoubtedly damage the business and a peaceful, sensible resolution needs to be found as soon as possible.

Act quickly before attitudes become irrevocably entrenched. It is in everyone's interests to resolve the situation. You did get on together once so reminding your partner of this may help you to come together again for the disposal at the best price, which means of a successful (not divided) business.
